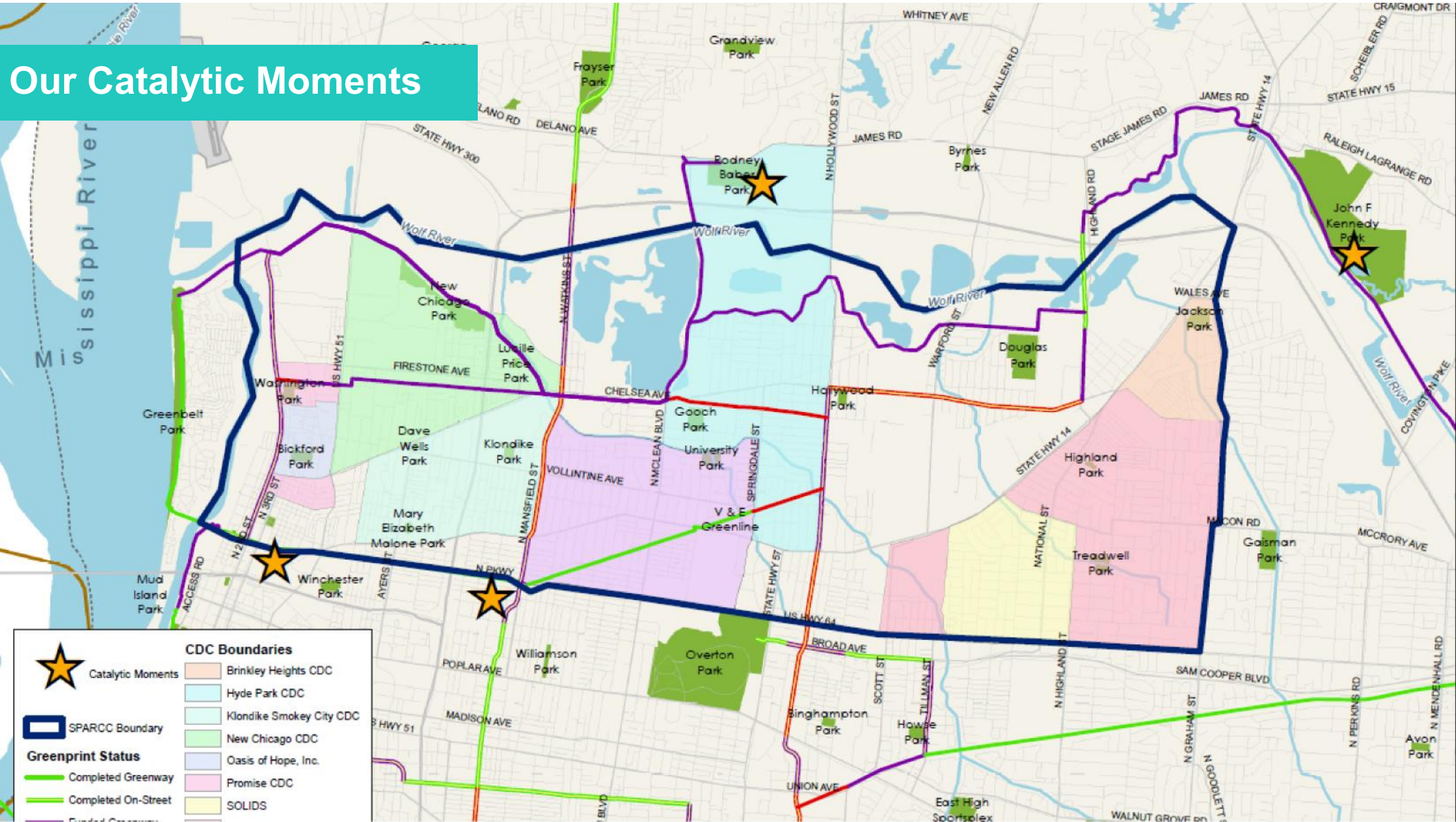
Mississippi River flooding: After levee blast, threat shifts to Memphis

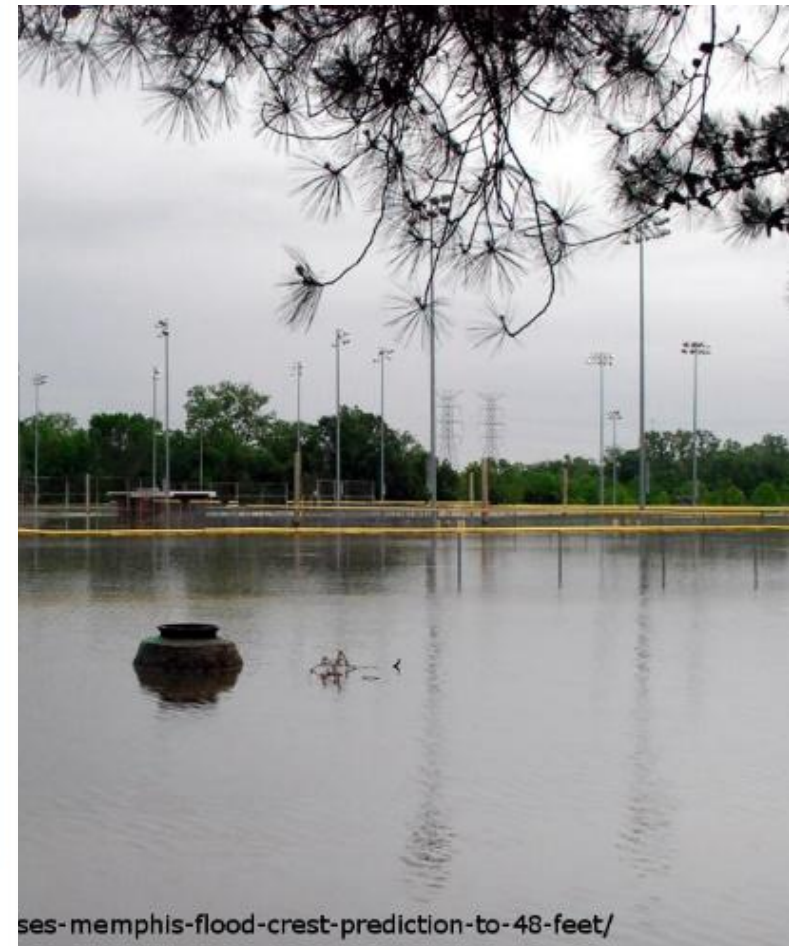

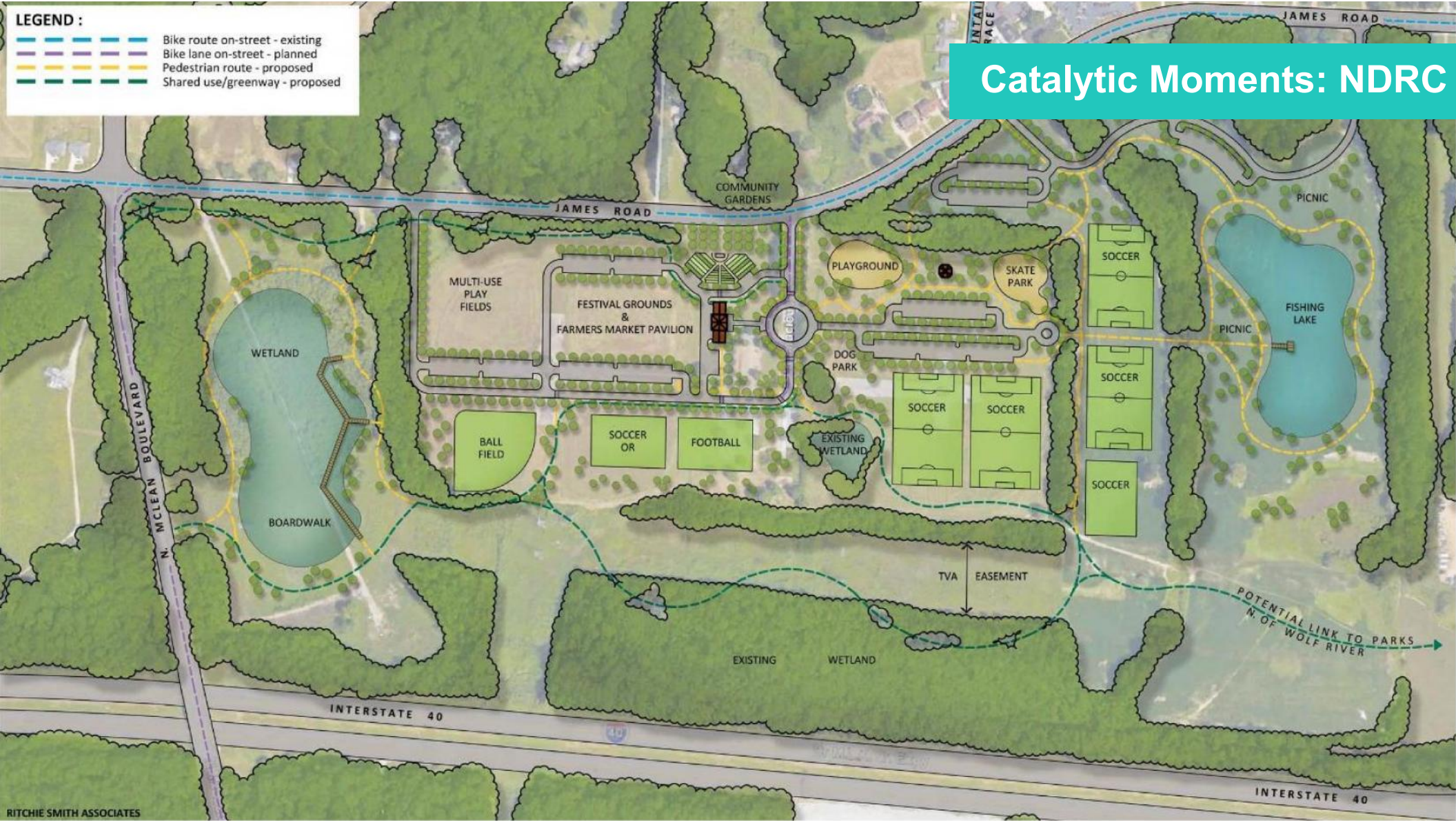

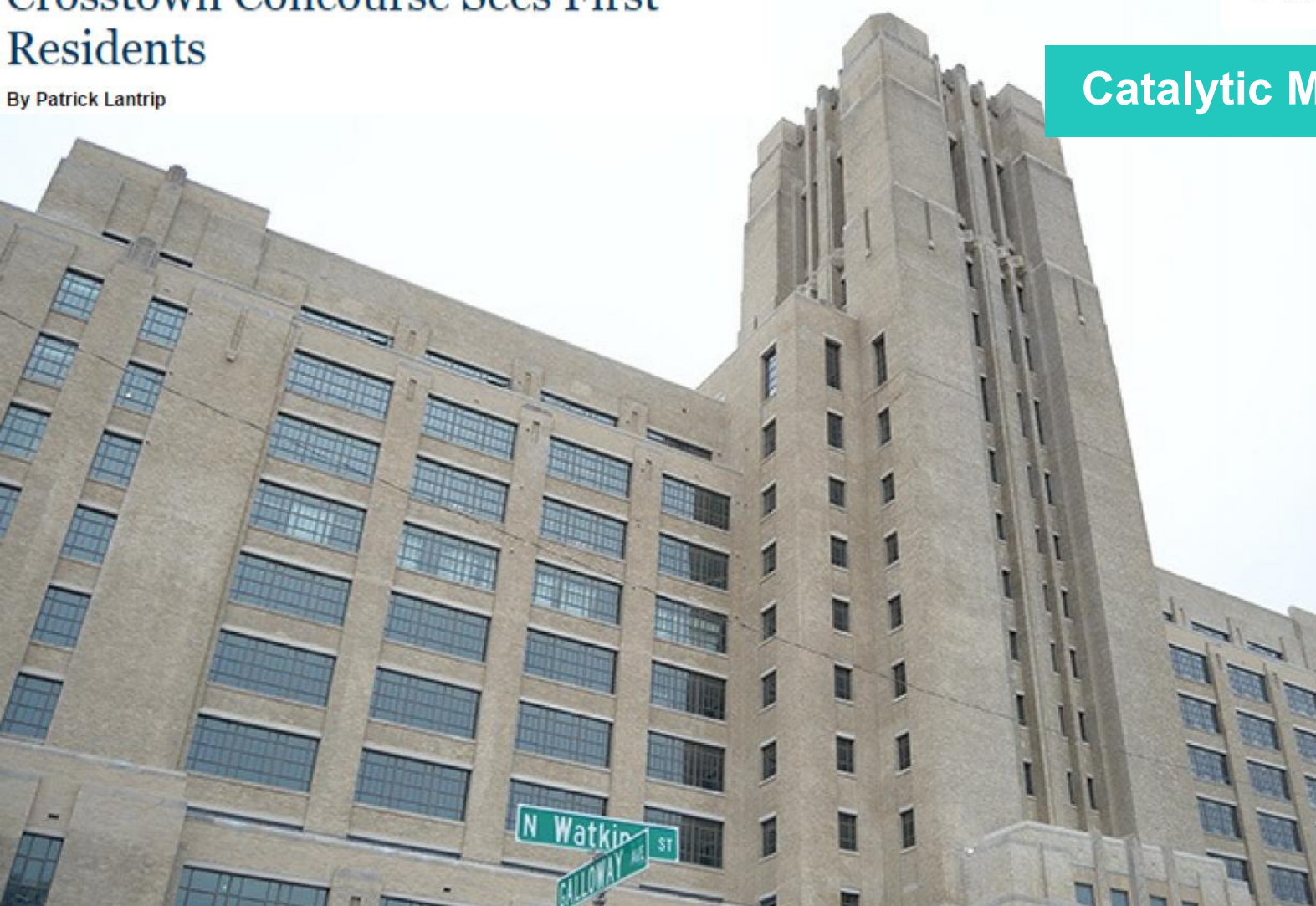
